The quarterly humanitarian/service project chosen for April - June to give sisters an opportunity to serve is to make pillowcases for children with cancer. The pillowcases will be donated to the Logan Chapter of Ryan's Case for Smiles. They will then be packaged and distributed to Logan Regional Hospital, Cache Valley Hospital, and McKay-Dee Hospital in Ogden. As their logo shows, Ryan's Case for Smiles is dedicated to "helping kids feel better to heal better." A pillowcase takes only a few minutes to make and makes a big difference in a sick child's life livening up their day and providing a positive distraction to the struggles they face.





To make the pillowcases shown, a one-page instruction sheet has been prepared and available through your Ward humanitarian/service coordinator. They will be available in Relief Society meetings and emailed with Relief Society newsletters. Choose fun, bright 100% cotton fabrics with kid-friendly designs (no flannel or glitter, please). Each pillowcase takes 3/4 yard fabric for the body of the case and 1/3 yard for the coordinating border. There are many fun ways of making pillowcases, including the "Hot Dog" and "Burrito" methods.
